

Schools are selected for participation



Based on:

Internationally benchmarked criteria that carefully designed and applied through various evaluation stages.


Leading to:

This process is carried out by:

Locally trained evaluators, who are experts in applying Mawhiba's specific selection methods and criteria, are also tasked with developing tools and mechanisms that enhance the performance of participating schools. This guarantees the delivery of the highest quality academic programs and the creation of optimal learning environments for gifted students.











Government Model

This model is designed to establish partnerships with **public schools dedicated to gifted student's education** or those that already host gifted student classes within various educational directorates, provided they meet the partnership school enrollment criteria. The objective is to reach a broader segment of gifted students.

Supervision and monitoring responsibilities are assigned to the Gifted Education Departments within the respective Education Directorates. The core model remains in place, with students continuing to take the annual assessment at the end of each academic year. The partnership agreement is valid for a period of three years, renewable upon mutual agreement.









Partnership Model

This is a contractual framework between **Mawhiba and selected schools**, guaranteeing that schools benefit from the full range of services offered by Mawhiba, including:

For gifted students from Grade 4 through Grade 12. After a three-year period, the school's performance is again evaluated.

If the school meets the required standards, the agreement is renewed. This model applies specifically to schools with existing agreements with Mawhiba, as well as to schools that have successfully completed the designated period under either the Support or Classification models.





Classification Model

The Classification Model is a contractual framework between Mawhiba and selected schools, designed to ensure that these schools benefit from the full range of services provided by Mawhiba, including:



In return, the schools commit to offering:

10 seats for scholarship with 100% discount, 10 seats for scholarship with 50% discount, and 20 seats for scholarship with 25% discount - all offered for a period of 3 years, with each scholarship covering a duration of 3 years per student.

40 Educational Scholarships

Scholarships are allocated based on the performance level of nominated students in the Mawhiba Multiple Cognitive Aptitude Test (MMCAT). The higher a student's score, the greater the tuition discount offered by the school. Full (100%) scholarships are granted to students in Grade 4, Grade 7, and Grade 10. Scholarships offering 50% or 25% discounts are available across all grade levels. After three years, the school's performance is re-evaluated, and if the school meets the required criteria, a new agreement is signed and the school transitions to the Partnership Model.








Support Model

A contractual model between **Mawhiba and selected schools**, specifically designed for schools located in medium and small cities, with the possibility of implementation in the outskirts of larger cities where no partnership schools currently exist. The model ensures the following:



In return, host schools commit to:

Providing no fewer than **250 free seats** for the Mawhiba Multiple Cognitive Aptitude Test (MMCAT) under the National Program for Gifted Identification.

Offering at least 20 scholarships annually, distributed as follows:

5 seats for scholarship with 100% discount, 5 seats for scholarship with 50% discount, and 10 seats for scholarship with 25% discount, all offered for a period of one year, with each scholarship covering a duration of 3 years per student.
